

# Report of Activities 2009-10

#### September -October 2009

- 1. Evaluation of the Existing School Model and Curriculum completed and documented. This was done through-
  - Observations throughout the day
  - Evaluation of documents and records
  - Evaluation of the available resources (human, time, material, equipment etc) in the organization and their utilization
  - Observation and evaluation of HR systems and policies being followed
  - Observation and evaluation of systems and policies being followed for students and families
  - Feedback from staff and a few parents

#### October-November 2009

#### November-December 2009

- Encourage staff to work as a team An Employees handbook was drafted and shared with all the staff members. in November 2009. The purpose is to maintain transparency and to follow a common code of conduct amongst the staff which is crucial for team building. We started implementing it w.e.f. 1 December 2009.
- ii. Efficient utilization of resources (financial, human, time and space) A number of systems have been put in place to ensure efficient utilization of resources. These systems have also been documented in the handbook. This includes the identification and purchase of equipment for the new school.

2. In service trainings /sessions These have been used as the medium for implementing the new curriculum framework. The following areas have been covered in the period - meaning of inclusion, holistic planning, planning and working as a team, assessments of our current students, planning and organizing of learning experiences, guidelines for working with parents.

1. Handed back the old school building ( sushant lok I)













# 2. Moved into the new school building on 8<sup>th</sup> March

4. Field trip at Sohna










May 2010
